Page 132 Text Tool (T) Justify Text

Probably the easiest way to justify text in Photoshop Elements is to:

1. Activate the Text Tool (T) and drag out a text box
2. Type your text
3. Press Ctrl>Shift>J before you click on the ✓.
4. If you already committed your text and used a text box you can highlight the text and then Ctrl>Shift>J to justify the text.
